

Dear Festival Friend:

The Rapids River Days Parade committee welcomes your participation in the 23rd Annual "Rapids River Days Parade," on Friday, June 26, 2026 at 6:00 pm. Please review the attached parade information and entry forms for the 2026 parade. Don't delay! The festival is right around the corner and all parade entries are due by Saturday, June 13th.

All units must be fully decorated!! (ONE unit = one separate vehicle or one vehicle pulling a trailer/ float. More than one unit will be charged an additional entry fee.) Parade entry fees are: \$200.00 per business unit, \$200.00 per politician, \$125.00 per non-profit unit, \$75.00 per royalty or dignitary unit, and NO CHARGE for colorguards, veteran organizations and Sauk Rapids service units. PARADE SPONSORS who provide \$600.00 will receive free participation and promotional perks (free units in parade, free promos on website/media). A \$25 Late Fee applies to all entries received after the deadline: JUNE 13, 2026. (Fees help support the parade each year by covering insurance, marching band judging fees, awards, and other promotional expenses.)

All units will be judged in the Float Contest!! The Float Contest will award \$200 to each winning unit in 6 categories: Best Business, Best Non-Profit, Best Youth Group, Storm Green & Gold, We Love Sauk Rapids, and Top Truck. (Parade entry fees apply as noted above). A panel of judges will select the winners. Awards will be given the week following the parade and winners will be announced in local media. See Float Contest Flyer on page 6 or on the festival website for more information.

The signed LIABILITY WAIVER must accompany your application form and entry fee or your unit will not be considered. Please be reminded, there will be NO REFUNDS and NO EXCHANGES of paid entry fees. Your line-up number will be emailed the week before the parade. Staging of units will take place on 11th Street North between Summit Avenue N and 6th Avenue N. (See MAP on page 5). Line up begins at 5:00pm (earlier if needed) and the parade starts at 6:00pm sharp!

We look forward to your participation in the Rapids River Days Parade and hope you enjoy all the festivities during the 23rd Annual Rapids River Days Festival in Sauk Rapids!

2026 Rapids River Days Parade RULES

We are expecting more than 85 units including 14 marching bands in this year's parade and we ask your cooperation in adhering to the following rules:

- 1. The PARADE starts at 6:00 pm SHARP on Friday, June 26, 2026. The route runs from Pleasantview Elementary School on Sixth Avenue North, heading south on Sixth Avenue (there is a Roundabout on 2nd St N), then turning left on 1st Street South and ending at Summit Avenue near the Sauk Rapids-Rice Middle School. Floats/units must turn LEFT or RIGHT on Summit Avenue to exit parade. Please, NO PARKING on EXIT ROUTES! (SEE MAP)
- 2. Line-up begins at 5:00 pm and all units MUST be ready at least 15 minutes prior to the 6:00 pm start of the parade. A driver must be present at all times with each mobile unit. The line-up area is in a residential district. We ask you to STAY OFF of private property. DO NOT BLOCK DRIVEWAYS or INTERSECTIONS. DO NOT LITTER! Be extra careful and courteous at all times.
- See the Parade Route and Directional Map to view FLOAT/UNIT STAGING areas. Numbered stakes will be placed along designated streets. Position your float or unit near the stake, according to the number you will be given.
- 4. Please CHECK-IN your parade unit at the "Check-In Point" (corner of Summit Ave N and 11th St N) when you arrive. This will assist us in an orderly line-up. Please be careful when entering the line-up area! NOTE: Most units will park on the LEFT SIDE OF THE ROAD facing 6th Ave N (Pleasantview School), as close to the curb as possible, at your designated number. NOTE: 11th Street will have barricades to minimize public traffic and they will be opened and closed only by city staff.
- 5. Vehicles not in the actual parade must drop off participants and leave the line-up area. Vehicles may be parked on residential streets near the Float Staging area but NOT on 11th Street North. Please plan "participant pick-ups" at Mississippi Heights School or separate locations outside of the Staging Area and Parade Route. Do not plan pick-ups near the Middle School. Only Marching Bands and band students will be allowed into the Middle School grounds area.
- 6. All vehicles must be safe and clean. Maximum height of units is 15 feet and the maximum width is 20 feet. ALL UNITS MUST BE FULLY DECORATED!!!! Please add colorful fringe to pulling vehicles as well. The number of vehicles allowed per UNIT entry is limited to one vehicle or one vehicle pulling a trailer/float; additional units are charged separately; all decisions will be determined by the parade committee. DO NOT bring more vehicles than you have indicated and paid for on your application as the lineup area will NOT have additional space!
- 7. ALL UNITS will be announced and judged! \$200 CASH awards will be given for Best Business Unit, Best Non-Profit Unit, and Best Youth Group; PLUS...Judges will have the option to select a Best Storm Green & Gold Unit, Best We LOVE Sauk Rapids Unit, and Best Top Truck Unit with \$200 to winners if chosen. Winners will be listed on the RRDays website and in local newspapers. Announcers and Float Judges will be situated on the corner of 1st Street N and 6th Avenue N. Watch for signs to prepare for the judging area.
- 8. **CANDY**, coupons, brochures, etc. must be HANDED OUT along the sides of the road, **NEVER THROWN FROM YOUR UNIT!!**All handouts must be done by walkers (age appropriate) along the sides of the road. Be cautious of small children who are not watching out for vehicles. Please report anyone who is not following this rule.
- 9. We do not allow any water spraying, throwing/shooting anything from parade units nor along the route, nor utilizing equipment that causes distractions such as loud gun shots, bubble machines, sparklers, etc.! Please report anyone not following this rule.
- 10. Animal entries must have a separate "clean up crew" following their unit through the parade OR animals must be diapered if a clean-up crew is not utilized. This is mandatory as we have many walkers and marching bands on foot in the parade.
- 11. NO alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the line-up areas or in the parade. Please report anyone who is not following this rule.
- 12. **DO NOT CREATE GAPS!** Please stay 15 feet from the unit in front of you, maintaining a smooth pace with the parade. Please follow instructions of Parade Officials to ensure the safety of participants as well as the viewing audience. No racing of engines or careless driving of motorized units. Absolutely no riders on equipment or parts of vehicles not designed as seating areas.
- 13. Portable restrooms with hand sanitizer will be available along the lineup and band areas, as well as along the parade route.


